QUICK HITTERS

- West Virginia (10-0) matched the 2002-03 program for the second-best start in program history with a 91-33 win over USC Upstate on Dec. 10. WVU held the Spartans to 33 points, the lowest since limiting Georgetown to 32 in 2012.
- No. 14 WVU is one of 11 teams in the NCAA Division I that remain undefeated.
- Lanay Montgomery led WVU with 16 points, 10 rebounds and five blocked shots.
- Montgomery needs six blocks to surpass former teammate Asya Bussie (270) for second all-time in career blocks. Montgomery is fourth nationally with 3.4 blocks per game.
- Tynice Martin leads the Big 12 with 18.5 points per game, while teammate Chania Ray is second with 6.1 assists per game. Teana Muldrow is second on the team with 13.6 ppg.
- WVU's field goal percentage defense of 28.7% is No. 1 nationally.
- WVU and Longwood (1-6) meet for the fifth time on Saturday. The Mountaineers won the previous meeting, 74-43, in Morgantown on Dec. 16, 2015. WVU leads the series, 4-0.

SCOUTING LONGWOOD

- Longwood (1-6) has lost three consecutive games including a 66-61 loss at Charlotte on Sunday.
- The Lancers are averaging 53.0 points per game and allowing opponents to score 79.0 points per contest. Longwood is shooting 33.3 percent from the field compared to its opposition's 43.9 percent.
- Kemari Jones leads the Lancers with 8.7 points and 7.2 rebounds in six contests. Freshman Jada Russell is averaging 8.0 points and leads the Lancers with 11 three-pointers this season.
- Longwood is the third Big South opponent for West Virginia this season. WVU picked up victories over Charleston Southern (88-38) and High Point (82-59). Overall, WVU is 7-2 all-time against Big South competition.
- Bill Reinson is in his seventh season at Longwood and holds a 48-134 record during his tenure with the Lancers.

LAST TIME OUT

- West Virginia powered its way to a 91-33 win over USC Upstate on Dec. 10. The 33 points scored by the Spartans were the lowest for a WVU opponent since Georgetown was held to 32 in 2012.
- WVU's 59.7 field goal percentage was its highest since shooting 64.4 percent vs. Youngstown State in 2012.
- Lanay Montgomery etched her fourth double-double of the year with 16 points and 10 rebounds. Montgomery also blocked five shots in the contest.
- Also, Kristina King had 16 points and nine rebounds. Other double-figure scorers included 15 points from Teana Muldrow and 14 from Tynice Martin.

A BLAZING START

- West Virginia's 10-0 start is tied for the second-best in program history, matching a 10-0 mark to open the 2002-03 season.
- West Virginia opened the 2010-11 campaign with a 16-0 start for the best opening in program history. WVU's top four starts are all under coach Mike Carey.
- WVU is one of 11 DI NCAA teams that are still undefeated. Other teams are: UConn (9-0), South Florida (8-0), Virginia Tech (10-0), Oklahoma State (8-0), Maryland (11-0), Buffalo (8-0), California (9-0), Colorado (9-0), Utah (9-0) and Mississippi State (10-0).

PHYSICAL FOR 40

- West Virginia has limited its first 10 opponents this season to less than 40 percent shooting and five of those less than 30 percent: Charleston Southern (17.7%), Howard (32.0%), Coppin State (22.6%), NC A&T (32.2%), ECU (35.8%), Auburn (27.6%), High Point (35.6%), Morehead State (29.4%), Ole Miss (32.2%) and USC Upstate (23.7%).
- Through 10 games, opponents are shooting just 28.7 percent (169-of-589) which leads the NCAA in field goal percentage defense.
- WVU has converted 193 opponent turnovers (19.3 TOPG) into 220 points (22.0 ppg) this season.
- The Mountaineers have 100 steals (10.0 spg) on the season and reached double-digit steals in 6-of-10 games.
- The 11 field goals for Charleston Southern marked the 17th time in program history that WVU has held an opponent to 11 or fewer field goals in a game since 2004.
- In the win over Coppin State, WVU's 14 blocks were the 10th-most in program history and the highest since deflecting 14 against Temple on April 1, 2015.
- USC Upstate's 33 points were the lowest scored for a Mountaineer opponent since Georgetown was limited to 32 points on March 4, 2012.

HARD TIME TO FIND A DIME

- West Virginia has limited nine of its first 10 opponents to scoring less than 10 points in at least one quarter.
- The Mountaineers have held opponents under double figures in 14 quarters this season.
- The most points allowed in a quarter this season was 24 against NC A&T (Nov. 22) and Ole Miss (Dec. 4).
- ECU was limited to four points in the fourth quarter on Nov. 23, tying a record-low for points scored in a quarter by a WVU opponent.

THE THREE MOUNTAINEERS

- West Virginia's three Ms (Tynice Martin, Lanay Montgomery and Teana Muldrow) provide the bulk of the Mountaineers' offense with an average of 43.5 points scored per game.
- Martin leads the Big 12 with 18.5 points per game. She has reached double-figures in 12 consecutive games dating back to March 18, 2016. Martin has made a field goal in 20 consecutive games.
- Muldrow is second on the squad with 13.6 points per contest and 8.9 rebounds per game. Muldrow's rebound average is fourth in the league. Muldrow has made a field goal in 19 consecutive games.
- Montgomery is second in the Big 12 with 10.0 rebounds. She leads the league with 3.4 blocked shots per game and 4.2 offensive rebounds per game.
- Montgomery and Muldrow have combined for seven double-doubles this season, including back-to-back double-double games against High Point and Morehead State.
- The duo are the first Mountaineer tandem since Takisha Granberry and Liz Repella in November 2008 to record double-doubles in back-to-back games.

A TIME CRUNCH

- West Virginia has led for 384 minutes and 44 seconds out of 400 minutes in the first 10 games. WVU has only trailed for a total of 3:44 - :13 seconds vs. Howard; 1:35 against Auburn and :35 seconds against Morehead State; 1:21 vs. Ole Miss.

STREAKS OF NOTE

- A win on Saturday would tie for the seventh-longest win streak in program history.
- Lanay Montgomery has blocked at least one shot in 45 of the last 48 contests.
- Montgomery has at least one rebound in 84 consecutive games.
- Teana Muldrow has a rebound in 47 consecutive games.
- West Virginia's Tynice Martin has reached double-figure scoring in 18 of her last 20 games, including the last 10 contests.
- Martin has made at least one trey in the last five games.
- Martin has made a field goal in 20 consecutive games, while Muldrow has connected on at least one bucket in the last 19 games.

CREDENTIALS

Photographers and media members who wish to cover a game at the WVU Coliseum should contact women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance. Credential pickup is located at the Gold Gate and opens one hour prior to each game.

GAMEDAY

Parking is free and open to the public in the Coliseum parking lot. Parking passes will be provided for only games that coincide with WVU men's basketball games.

The working press area is located on the east side of the main floor at concourse level (22 rows from the playing floor). Press should enter through the Gold Gate with their credentials. Forty-eight seats are available for working media; four television slings are also available. West Virginia grants broadcast rights to the official radio outlet of the visiting team on reciprocal basis.

Accredited photographers may work along the playing floor at both baselines behind the restriction line established by the NCAA. Cutline writers or equipment carriers are not permitted on the playing floor.

The WVU Coliseum also supports wireless internet access. Please see women's basketball contact Russell Luna for login and password information.

Complete statistics are provided to all working media at halftime and postgame. Requested team members and coach Carey will be available for interviews following a 15-minute grace period.

DURING THE WEEK

Any member of the media wishing to interview a player or member of the coaching staff during the week should contact West Virginia women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance.

Cell phone numbers will not be made available and all WVU student-athletes have been instructed to not conduct interviews without prior approval of the athletic communications staff.

ALMOST HEAVEN, WEST VIRGINIA

- West Virginia has won a school-record 31 consecutive nonconference games inside the WVU Coliseum dating back to Nov. 24, 2013.
- The Mountaineers last lost against a nonconference opponent at the WVU Coliseum came to Ohio State on Nov. 8, 2013, with WVU falling 70-61.
- The previous record of 19 lasted from Dec. 30, 2008 to Jan. 2, 2011.
- West Virginia is 103-7 (.936) at home against nonconference opponents since 2002.
- WVU's current 12-game win streak at the WVU Coliseum is seventh-longest all-time.
- WVU is 189-46 (.804) all-time at home under Mike Carey, including 17-0 in 2010.
- WVU has registered nine undefeated seasons at home against nonconference competition in 15 years under Mike Carey.
- WVU has reached 10+ home wins in 11 of 15 seasons under Mike Carey.
- WVU has won 80 percent or more of its home games in seven of the last eight years.
- WVU is 395-165 (.705) at the Coliseum all-time.

NATION'S BEST

- West Virginia sits in the top 15 nationally in six statistical categories.
- Through games on Dec. 14, WVU leads the country in field goal percentage defense (28.7%) and is second in scoring defense (49.5 ppg), third in blocked shots per game (7.2 bpg), fifth in scoring margin (+30.5), 10th in rebounding margin (+12.6) and 11th in 3-point defense (24.2%).
- Chania Ray is 26th nationally and second in the Big 12 with 6.1 assists per game.
- Tynice Martin paces the Big 12 and is 52nd in the NCAA with 18.5 points per game.
- Laney Montgomery's 3.4 blocked shots per game are first in the league and fourth nationally.
- Montgomery leads the Big 12 and ranks 26th in the NCAA with 4.2 offensive rebounds per game.
- She is second in the league with 10.0 rebounds, which ranks 31st nationally.

WVU NO. 14 IN THE POLLS

- West Virginia remained at No. 14 in the USA TODAY Sports Coaches Poll and fell one spot to No. 14 in the Associated Press Poll.
- The Mountaineers were in both preseason polls for the fourth time. Other years include: 2014-15 (17 AP/17 Coaches), 2010-11 (11 AP/11 Coaches) and 2007-08 (18 AP/20 Coaches).
- WVU was tabbed to finish fourth in the Big 12 coaches preseason poll.
- Other Big 12 Top 25 teams include: Baylor (3/4), Texas (16/17) and Oklahoma (20/22).

LANAY NEARING NO. 2 IN BLOCKS

- Center Lanay Montgomery is third all-time at WVU with 265 career blocked shots. She is six away from reaching second place currently held by Asya Bussie (270).
- Montgomery's blocked shot total is fifth all-time in the Big 12.
- She has 725 total rebounds, which ranks 10th all-time at West Virginia.
- Additionally, Montgomery has corralled 254 career offensive rebounds, which is sixth. She is 11 away from reaching the top five.
- If trends continue, Montgomery can become the Mountaineers' best shooter in program history surpassing Olayinka Sanni (55.7%). Her career field goal percentage of 57.5% currently ranks first at WVU.
- Montgomery opened her senior season with a bang, scoring 17 points and grabbing 18 rebounds in the win over Charleston Southern (Nov. 12).
- Montgomery's 17/18 performance is the best for a Mountaineer since Donna Abbott inked 22 points and grabbed 19 rebounds against Rutgers Feb. 1991.
- She joined Georgeann Wells (1984) as the only Mountaineers to score 20+, rebound 18+ and block 5+ in a game.
- Montgomery tallied a career-high 23 points, grabbed 18 rebounds and blocked six shots against Morehead State on Nov. 30.
- On Dec. 7, Montgomery garnered NCAA Weekly Starting Five honors for her performance against Morehead State.
- Montgomery was named a nominee for the Allstate Good Works Team on Nov. 30.

MARTIN ON A ROLL

- Sophomore Tynice Martin has been on fire since Feb. 13, 2016. The sophomore has reached double-figures in 18 of the last 20 contests, including 12 consecutive.
- During that stretch, Martin is averaging 15.9 points per game (318 points in 20 games).
- This season, she is averaging 18.5 points per game, which leads the Big 12.
- West Virginia is 5-0 when Martin scores 20 or more points in a game.
- She netted a career-high 28 points and matched a career-best nine field goals in the win over North Carolina A&T on Nov. 22. Martin added another 27 points against Howard on Nov. 15. Martin tallied 21 points in the win over High Point (Nov. 27).

Martin Nets Career-Best 28 in Return Home

Atlanta native Tynice Martin excelled in her return home to Georgia, scoring a career-high 28 points in the No. 19/23-ranked West Virginia University women's basketball team's, 80-64, win over North Carolina A&T on day one of the Savannah Invitational.

West Virginia (4-0) came out on fire with a 22-2 run in the first quarter. The Aggies (1-3) outscored WVU, 24-13, in the third quarter to trim the Mountaineer lead to 13. However, a 9-1 West Virginia run in the fourth quarter helped the Mountaineers squash the North Carolina A&T comeback attempt.

Martin made 9-of-15 from the field and finished with a career-best 28 points, while dishing out three assists and collecting two steals. She connected on 9-of-9 from the charity stripe, pushing her consecutive free throw streak to 28 makes since March 18, 2016.

Teana Muldrow added 15 points and corralled a season-high nine rebounds. Chania Ray added nine points and dished out six assists in the victory. Katrina Pardee and Kristina King each added eight points. Center Lanay Montgomery, largely limited due to foul trouble, finished with seven rebounds, four points and three blocks.

West Virginia shot 44.6 percent (25-of-56) from the field and 32.2 percent (19-of-59) from behind the three-point line. North Carolina A&T was the fifth straight Mountaineer opponent to shoot less than 40 percent, connecting on 19-of-59 for 32.2 percent. The Aggies made 6-of-13 from behind the arc for 46.2 percent.

The Mountaineers sprinted out to a 22-2 and held a 28-8 advantage at the end of the first quarter. In a stretch halfway through the quarter, Martin made four consecutive free throws and hit two jumpers as Pardee netted a triple to push the Mountaineers lead to 20.

The second half was much closer as the Aggies became the first WVU opponent to reach 20 points in a quarter this season. Montgomery and Muldrow were limited in the quarter with two fouls each. The Mountaineers led 52-28 at the break. WVU shot 51.5 percent (17-of-33) from the field compared to NC A&T's 23.5 percent (8-of-34).

WVU Women's Hoops Improve to 10-0

The No. 13/14-ranked West Virginia University women's basketball team shot a season-high 59.7 percent from the field and improved to 10-0 in a 91-33 victory over USC Upstate on Saturday.

West Virginia opened the contest on an 11-2 run and never trailed. The Mountaineers used a 21-0 scoring spurt in the third and fourth quarters to pick up their 31st consecutive win over a nonconference opponent at the WVU Coliseum. WVU's 12th straight win at the Coliseum ranks seventh all-time, while the 10-game win streak is tied for the 10th longest in program history. Saturday's win also tied the Mountaineers second-best start in program history, matching the 10-0 start in 2002-03. USC Upstate's 33 points were the lowest for a Mountaineer opponent since Georgetown was limited to 32 in 2012. The Spartans fell to 4-6 on the season.

Senior center Lanay Montgomery recorded her fourth double-double of the year with 16 points and 10 rebounds. She blocked four shots and made 8-of-9 from the field for an 88.9 shooting percentage. For a second consecutive game, Kristina King matched season-highs with 16 points and nine rebounds in 19 minutes. Teana Muldrov finished with 15 points, six rebounds and five assists. Additionally, Tynice Martin eclipsed double-figures for a 12th consecutive game with 14 points.

Chania Ray finished with nine points and led WVU with seven assists and four steals. Sophomore Katrina Pardee also tallied nine points in the contest.

West Virginia limited its 11th consecutive opponent to less than 40 percent shooting as USC Upstate made just 14-of-59 for 23.7 percent. WVU dished out 24 assists and collected 14 steals in the victory.

Pardee scored West Virginia's first seven points as the Mountaineers opened the contest to an 11-2 lead. Montgomery also added eight points and blocked two shots in seven minutes in the opening quarter.

Six of the first eight points were scored by the USC Upstate to start the second quarter. Montgomery, King and Pardee sparked a 10-3 Mountaineer run. West Virginia closed the half with a 42-19 lead and shot a season-best 63.3 percent from the field in the opening half.

Muldrov made four of West Virginia's first six points in the second half, all of which came from the charity stripe. The Mountaineers closed the third quarter on a 14-point run to extend the margin to 45 points.

WVU added seven more consecutive points to stretch the lead to 79-26 with 7:40 remaining. A layup from Vanessa Agrusa snapped the 21-0 run, but WVU added 13 more points in the quarter for its largest margin of victory win of the season. Brittny Delva led the Spartans with 12 points.
