## QUICK HITTERS

- No. 19/25-ranked West Virginia (3-0) returns to action on Tuesday against North Carolina A&T (1-2) in the Savannah Invitational in Savannah, Georgia.
- The Mountaineers have the nation's second-best scoring defense, allowing opponents to score just 42.0 points per game. WVU's field goal percentage defense of 23.6% ranks fifth nationally. WVU has held its last four opponents below 40 percent shooting.
- Sophomore Tynice Martin led WVU with 19 points in the Mountaineers 69-39 win over Coppin State. Katrina Pardee registered a season-high 17 points and grabbed a career-best six rebounds. Lanay Montgomery recorded seven of WVU's 14 blocked shots.
- WVU and North Carolina A&T meet for the first time on the hardwood. The Mountaineers own a 21-3 record against MEAC competition, include two wins this season against Howard and Coppin State.
- WVU moved up two spots to No. 19 in the Associated Press poll released on Monday.

### TIDBITS:

- West Virginia and North Carolina A&T have never met on the hardwood.
- The Mountaineers own a 21-3 all-time record against schools in the MEAC.
- WVU has two wins over MEAC schools this season: Coppin State (69-39) and Howard (95-49).

## SCOUTING NC A&T

- North Carolina A&T (1-2) has losses to Georgia Southern (65-50) and Auburn (68-36) this season. The Aggies secured a 74-59 win over UT Martin in Greensboro on Nov. 14.
- Dana Brown leads the Aggies with 16.0 points per game and a team-leading 13 made three-pointers.
- Aliyah Kilpatrick paces the in rebounds (5.0 rpg), assists (4.3 apg) and steals (2.7 spg), while scoring 7.3 points per game.
- NC A&T is averaging 53.3 points per game compared to opponents' 64.0 points per contest. The Aggies are shooting 33.5 percent (58-of-173) from the field and 26.9 percent (18-of-67) from three-point range.
- Tarrell Robinson returns for his fifth season as head coach. Last season, he led the Aggies to a 19-12 overall record and a 12-4 mark in the MEAC. North Carolina A&T won the MEAC Championship game over Coppin State to advance to the NCAA Tournament.

## LAST TIME OUT

- Tynice Martin led the Mountaineers with 19 points in West Virginia's 69-39 win over Coppin State on Saturday.
- WVU held the Eagles to 22.6 percent shooting (14-of-61) from the field and 9.1 percent (1-of-11) from behind the arc.
- Sophomore Katrina Pardee tallied a season-high 17 points and pulled down a career-high six rebounds.
- Chania Ray dished out eight assists and grabbed a career-high seven boards.
- Lanay Montgomery blocked seven of WVU's 14 shots for the most deflections since April 2015 against Temple.

## NCAA LEADERS

- While it is still early in the season, West Virginia sits in the top 15 nationally in multiple statistical categories.
- WVU is No. 2 in scoring defense (42.0), No. 2 in field goal percentage defense (23.6%), No. 5 in scoring margin (+42.0), No. 10 in 3-point defense (17.6%), No. 12 in rebounds (51.0 rpg) and No. 13 in blocked shots (7.3 bpg).
- Chania Ray is eighth nationally with 8.0 assists per game.
- Lanay Montgomery is 12th in the NCAA with 12.7 rebounds per game and 16th with 3.3 blocked shots per game.

## PHYSICAL FOR FOUR DEFENSE

- West Virginia has limited its first three opponents to less than 40 percent shooting. The Mountaineers held Charleston Southern to 17.7 percent shooting (11-of-62), Howard to 32.0 percent (16-of-50) and Coppin State to 22.6 percent (14-of-62).
- WVU has converted 66 opponent turnovers to 84 points this season. The Mountaineers have 39 steals on the season and reached double-digit steals against Charleston Southern (10) and Coppin State (10).
- The 11 field goals for Charleston Southern marked the 17th time in program history that WVU has held an opponent to 11 or fewer field goals in a game since 2004.
- In the win over Coppin State, WVU's 14 blocks were the 10th-most in program history and the highest since deflecting 14 against Temple on April 1, 2015.

## THIRD QUARTER SUCCESS

- West Virginia has outscored its opponents by a combined 87-46 in the third quarter.
- The Mountaineers have shot over 60 percent in third quarter in every game this season: Charleston Southern (61.1%), Howard (64.7%) and Coppin State (61.5%).

## SAVANNAH INVITATIONAL

- WVU is participating in a regular-season tournament for the 18th consecutive year.
- The Mountaineers have finished unbeaten in 14 tournaments with the most recent occurring last season at the Florida Sunshine Classic in Winter Park, Florida.
- WVU picked up a pair of wins over James Madison and Indiana in the tournament.
- West Virginia makes only its second appearance in the Peach State after playing in the Georgia Southern Hampton Inn Classic in 1995.
- The Mountaineers went 1-1 in the tournament, collecting an 80-69 win over Liberty and falling, 78-63, to Drexel.
- Atlanta native Tynice Martin returns to her home state after a decorated high school career at Southwest Atlanta Christian Academy and Southwest DeKalb. In addition to multiple All-State honors, Martin was tabbed the 2015 Class A Player of the Year by the Atlanta Journal Constitution.
- WVU and East Carolina meet for the fifth time on Wednesday. The series is even at 2-2. WVU won the last contest 76-54 at Minges Coliseum in Greenville.
- WVU and Auburn have never met on the hardwood.

## WVU NO. 19 IN AP POLL

- West Virginia climbed two spots in the Associated Press poll to No. 19 on Monday.
- WVU remains No. 25 in the USA TODAY SPORTS Coaches Poll released Nov. 15.
- The Mountaineers were in both preseason polls for the fourth time. Other years include: 2014-15 (17 AP/17 Coaches), 2010-11 (11 AP/11 Coaches) and 2007-08 (18 AP/20 Coaches).
- WVU was tabbed to finish fourth in the Big 12 coaches preseason poll.
- Other Big 12 Top 25 teams include: Baylor (5/4), Oklahoma (13/17), Texas (14/10) and West Virginia (19/25).

## STREAKS OF NOTE

- Lanay Montgomery has blocked at least one shot in 27 consecutive games and 39 out of the last 40.
- West Virginia's Tynice Martin has reached double-figure scoring in 11 of her last 13 games, including the last five contests.
- Martin has made a field goal in 13 consecutive games, while Teana Muldrow has connected on at least one bucket in the last 12 games.
- Martin has connected on 19 consecutive free throws dating back to the Princeton game on March 18, 2016, in Columbus, Ohio.
- West Virginia has held its last four opponents below 40 percent shooting: Ohio State (37.1%), Charleston Southern (17.7%), Howard (32.0%) and Coppin State (22.6%).

### CREDENTIALS

Photographers and media members who wish to cover a game at the WVU Coliseum should contact women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance. Credential pickup is located at the Gold Gate and opens one hour prior to each game.

### GAMEDAY

Parking is free and open to the public in the Coliseum parking lot. Parking passes will be provided for only games that coincide with WVU men's basketball games.

The working press area is located on the east side of the main floor at concourse level (22 rows from the playing floor). Press should enter through the Gold Gate with their credentials. Forty-eight seats are available for working media; four television slings are also available. West Virginia grants broadcast rights to the official radio outlet of the visiting team on reciprocal basis.

Accredited photographers may work along the playing floor at both baselines behind the restriction line established by the NCAA. Outline writers or equipment carriers are not permitted on the playing floor.

The WVU Coliseum also supports wireless internet access. Please see women's basketball contact Russell Luna for login and password information.

Complete statistics are provided to all working media at halftime and postgame. Requested team members and coach Carey will be available for interviews following a 15-minute grace period.

### DURING THE WEEK

Any member of the media wishing to interview a player or member of the coaching staff during the week should contact West Virginia women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance.

Cell phone numbers will not be made available and all WVU student-athletes have been instructed to not conduct interviews without prior approval of the sports communications staff.

## ALMOST HEAVEN, WEST VIRGINIA

- West Virginia has won a school-record 27 consecutive nonconference games inside the WVU Coliseum dating back to Nov. 24, 2013.
- The Mountaineers last loss against a nonconference opponent at the WVU Coliseum came to Ohio State on Nov. 8, 2013, with WVU falling 70-61.

## MARTIN FINDING RHYTHM

- Sophomore Tynice Martin has been on fire since Feb. 13, 2016. The sophomore has reached double-figures in 11 of the last 13 contests, including five consecutive.
- During that stretch, Martin is averaging 19.0 points per game.
- Martin's career-high 27 points against Howard (Nov. 15) is the most for Mountaineer sophomore since Bria Holmes tallied 28 points against Texas Tech on Feb. 26, 2014.
- The Atlanta native is just the third WVU sophomore to finish perfect from the line in double figures after she went 10-of-10 from the charity stripe against Howard (Nov. 15).

## CAREY GETS WIN NO. 325 AT WVU

- Coach Mike Carey is in his 16th season at the helm of the Mountaineer women's basketball program.
- Carey collected his 325 win at West Virginia with a 69-39 victory over Coppin State.
- He produced 288 wins at Salem and has 325 victories at West Virginia.
- His .655 winning percentage in 16 seasons at WVU is a program-best.
- Mike Carey (613) recorded his 600th career win at the collegiate level with WVU's 72-35 victory over Kansas on Jan. 16, 2016.
- With a win over Morehead State on Dec. 2, 2015, Carey surpassed Kittie Blakemore as WVU's all-time wins leader.
- Carey will coach his 500th career game at West Virginia on Nov. 27 against High Point.

Montgomery Achieves Historic Feat in Opener

Senior Lanay Montgomery's recorded a historic performance of 17 points and 18 rebounds to pace the No. 22/25 ranked West Virginia University women's basketball team to a season-opening, 88-38, victory over Charleston Southern on Saturday.

West Virginia (1-0) sprinted out to an 11-3 lead before Charleston Southern (0-1) cut the game to 11-9 midway through the first quarter. WVU utilized a 12-2 run and held CSU scoreless for a seven minute stretch that lasted late in the second quarter and the first three minutes of the third quarter. The Mountaineers are now 13-3 all-time in season openers under Mike Carey and 29-15 all-time.

Montgomery was one of three WVU players to score 17 points in the contest and did something a Mountaineer had not accomplished in 25 years. The senior from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, connected a perfect 7-of-7 from the field and added 3-of-4 from the charity stripe in 21 minutes. Montgomery's impressive 17 point and 18 rebound performance was the best for a WVU women's basketball player since Donna Abbott posted 22 points and 19 rebounds against Rutgers on Feb. 28, 1991. The double-double marked the 10th in Montgomery's career and she has now pulled down double-digit boards in back-to-back games.

Overall, West Virginia connected on 50.8 percent (32-of-63) from the field and 39.1 percent from behind the arc (9-of-23). The Mountaineers held CSU to just 17.7 percent (11-of-62) shooting, as the Buccaneers became the 17th opponent in WVU program history to only make 11 or less field goals.

West Virginia outmanned Charleston Southern, 60-31, on the boards and outscored CSU 38-2 in the paint. WVU capitalized with 21 second chance points and 24 points off 16 Buccaneers turnovers.

Junior Teana Muldrow scored 17 points, collected seven rebounds, dished out three assists and snatched a pair of steals. Tynice Martin also eclipsed double figures with 17 points, making 7-of-13 from the field and 3-of-7 from the 3-point line.

Chania Ray distributed a career-high 11 assists - the most for a Mountaineer point guard since Linda Stepany recorded 12 against Saint Francis in Dec. 2014. Ray also registered four rebounds and two steals.

A couple of other Mountaineers reach career highs: Anja Martin tallied a personal-best eight points and Desiree Rhodes corralled a new career-high in 12 boards. Kristina King, the Big 12 Conference Preseason Newcomer of the Year, scored eight points in her WVU debut.

Martin's Career-High 27 Paces WVU Past Howard

Sophomore Tynice Martin netted a career-high 27 points to lead the No. 21/25-ranked West Virginia University women's basketball team to a 95-49 victory over Howard on Tuesday evening at the WVU Coliseum.

Howard senior Te'Shya Heslip's layout cut the WVU lead to 16-11 with 1:41 remaining in the first quarter. However, West Virginia answered with a 21-0 run that lasted six minutes into the second quarter.

The Mountaineers (2-0) tallied 54 of their 95 points in the second half to cruise to their 26th consecutive victory against a nonconference opponent at the WVU Coliseum.

Martin bested her previous career-high of 20 points and became the ninth WVU player to finish perfect from the free throw line with 10 or more points. The sophomore from Atlanta finished the evening 7-of-14 from the field, 3-of-9 from behind the arc and 10-of-10 from the free throw line. She grabbed four rebounds, collected three steals, dished out two assists and blocked two shots in 29 minutes.

In addition to Martin, four other Mountaineers eclipsed double-figures. Junior Chania Ray netted a career-best 17 points, going 7-of-14 from the field, while dishing out five assists and snatching a career-high five steals.

Alexis Brewer connected on a career-best three triples and finished 5-of-9 with 13 points. Big 12 Preseason Newcomer of the Year Kristina King tallied 12 points and corralled six rebounds. Teana Muldrow finished with 11 points, eight rebounds four assists and three steals. Lanay Montgomery blocked a shot for a 26th straight game and registered her third consecutive double-figure rebounding game with a game-high 13 boards. The senior scored seven points, just three shy of a double-double.

Overall, WVU shot 46.3 percent (31-of-67) from the field and 43.5 percent (10-of-23) from behind the arc. From the charity stripe, WVU knocked down 23-of-29 free throw attempts for 79.3 percent. Howard was limited to 32.0 percent shooting (16-of-51) from the field and 3-of-15 (20.0 percent) from behind the arc. The Mountaineers won the rebound battle, 48-28 and outscored Howard 32-18 in the paint. WVU forced 27 Howard turnovers and converted those into 34 points.

WVU Clipes Eagles to Complete Homestand

Three players reached double-figures in the West Virginia University women's basketball team's 69-39 victory over Coppin State on Saturday.

No. 21/25-ranked West Virginia (3-0) opened the game on a 10-0 run, but shot just 33.3 percent (11-of-33) in the opening half. For a third consecutive game, the Mountaineers bounced back and shot over 60 percent (8-of-13) in the third quarter and took command of the contest for the team's 27th consecutive win at the WVU Coliseum against nonconference opponents. With the loss, Coppin State fell to 0-4 on the year.

Sophomore Tynice Martin led all scorers with 19 points. Martin connected on six field goals and connected on a perfect 6-of-6 from the free throw line. The Atlanta native has now made 19 consecutive free throws dating back to the Princeton game on March 18, 2016, last season.

Katrina Pardee finished with a season-high 17 points and registered a career-high six rebounds in 29 minutes. Teana Muldrow tallied 11 points and pulled down seven rebounds for fourth consecutive double-figure scoring game. The junior made 5-of-8 from the field, snatched three steals and blocked two shots.

Lanay Montgomery had her best blocking performance since April 2015, leading the way with seven of WVU's 14 blocks on the evening. Montgomery also tallied seven points and grabbed seven rebounds. Chania Ray led WVU with eight assists, while grabbing seven rebounds and collecting three steals.

Overall, West Virginia shot 40.0 percent (24-of-60) from the field and 21.7 percent (5-of-23) from behind the three-point line. Coppin State became the fourth consecutive WVU opponent to shoot below 40 percent, connecting on just 22.6 percent (14-of-62) from the field and 9.1 percent (1-of-11) from behind the arc.

West Virginia opened the first quarter on a 10-0 run. However, Coppin State answered with a 7-4 run to close Mountaineer lead to 14-7 at the end of one.

Despite shooting just 25 percent (4-of-16) in the first quarter, the Mountaineers answered in the second quarter by connecting on 7-of-17 for 41.2 percent. WVU used a 13-0 run over a four minute span to push its lead to 24 points with four minutes remaining in the opening half. Pardee paced WVU with 10 points followed by eight from Martin.

Muldrow connected on nine of WVU's first 11 points to open the third quarter. West Virginia outscored CSU, 22-14, and held a 55-27 advantage after three periods. The Mountaineers added 14 more points in the fourth quarter to secure their ninth win over Coppin State.
